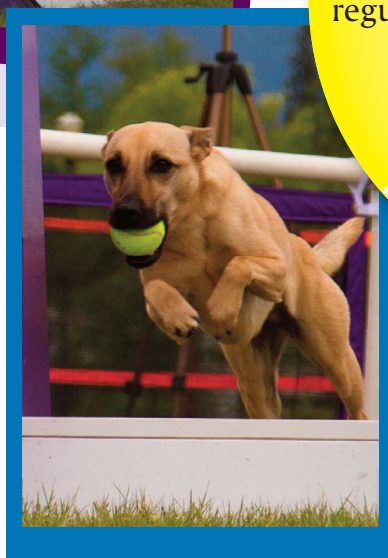

What is flyball?

Flyball is a fast-paced and exciting sport with teams of four dogs that compete in relay races. Each dog jumps over four hurdles, triggers a spring-loaded box, catches a ball, and returns over the hurdles.

Who is participating in the tournament?

There will be local and out-of-state competitors with a wide variety of breeds and mixes, including Border Collies, Pit Bulls, Labs, a Lhasa Apso (ranked #1 among the breed in North America), a Siberian Husky (ranked #5), a 70-pound Bernese Mountain Dog/Lab, a 14-pound Poodle mix, and many more!
