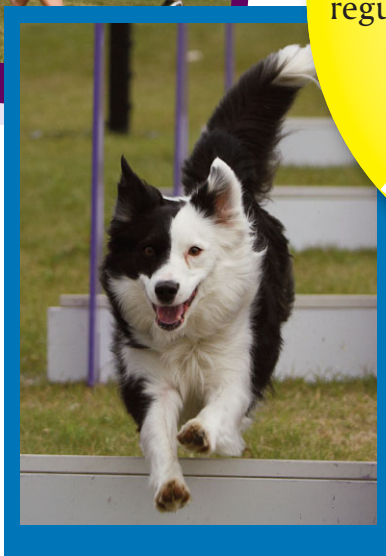

What is flyball?

Flyball is a fast-paced and exciting sport with teams of four dogs that compete in relay races. Each dog jumps over four hurdles spaced 10 feet apart, catches a ball from a spring-loaded box, and returns over the hurdles with the ball. The first team of four dogs to complete the course without errors wins the heat.

Who is participating in the tournament?

The competition will include a wide variety of breeds and mixes, large and small. Flyball is a great team sport involving handlers and helpers of all ages.
