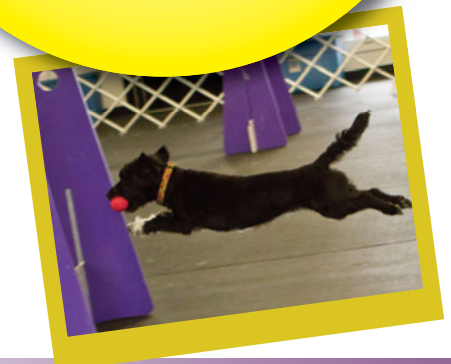
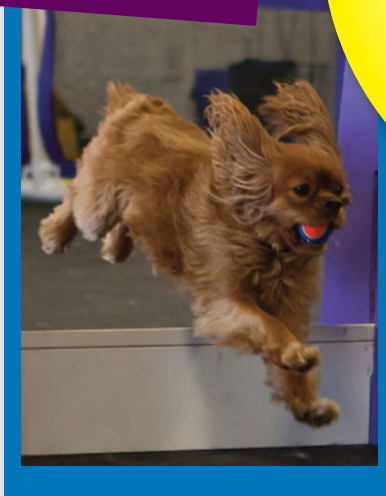
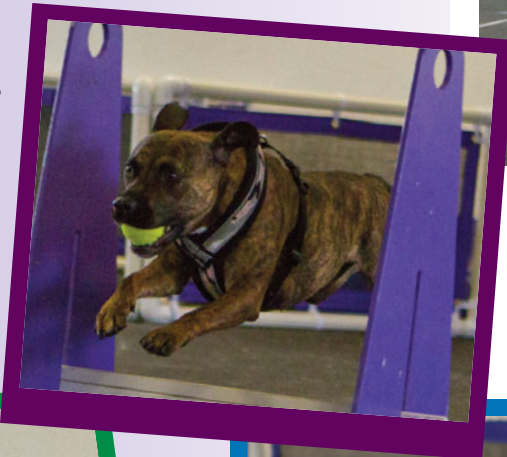

What is flyball?

Flyball is a fast-paced and exciting sport with teams of four dogs that compete in relay races. Each dog jumps over four hurdles, triggers a spring-loaded box, catches a ball, and returns over the hurdles.

Who is participating in the tournament?

The competition will include a wide variety of breeds and mixes, including Border Collies, American Pit Bull Terriers, Shelties, a Lhasa Apso, a Siberian Husky, a Belgian Sheepdog, a Cavalier King Charles Spaniel, a Bernese Mountain Dog/Lab mix, a 14-pound Poodle mix, and more!
